"Our flag does not fly because the wind moves it; it flies with the last breath of each soldier who died protecting it."

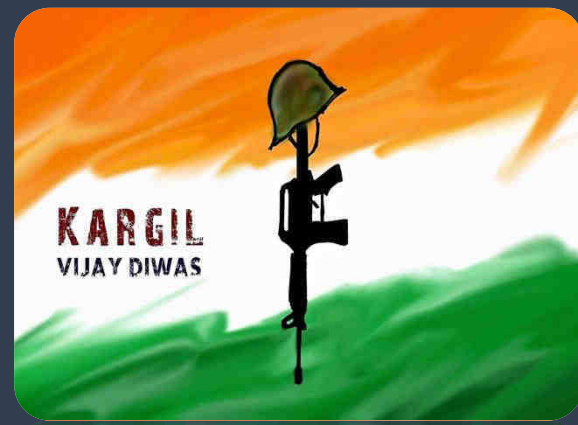

Just A Minute was the icing on the cake, students expressed their feelings for the soldiers and martyrs with great pride.



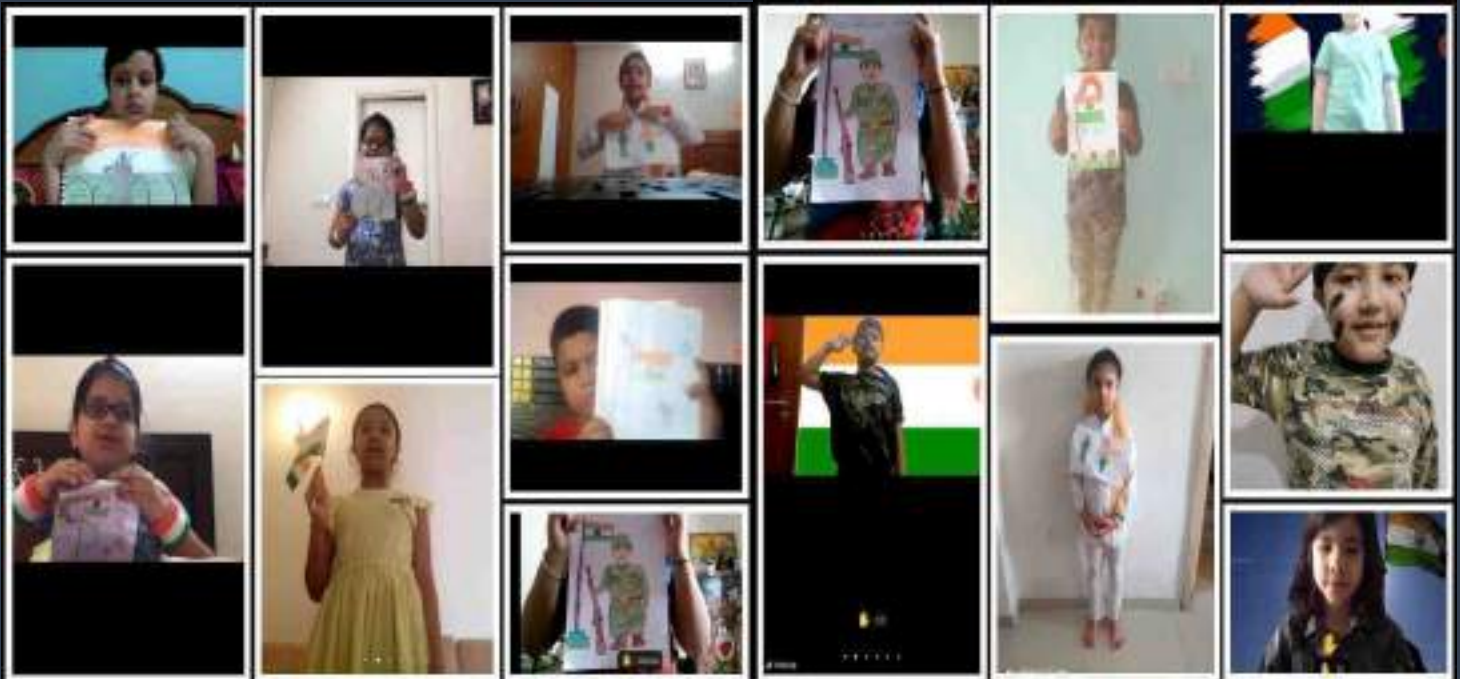
