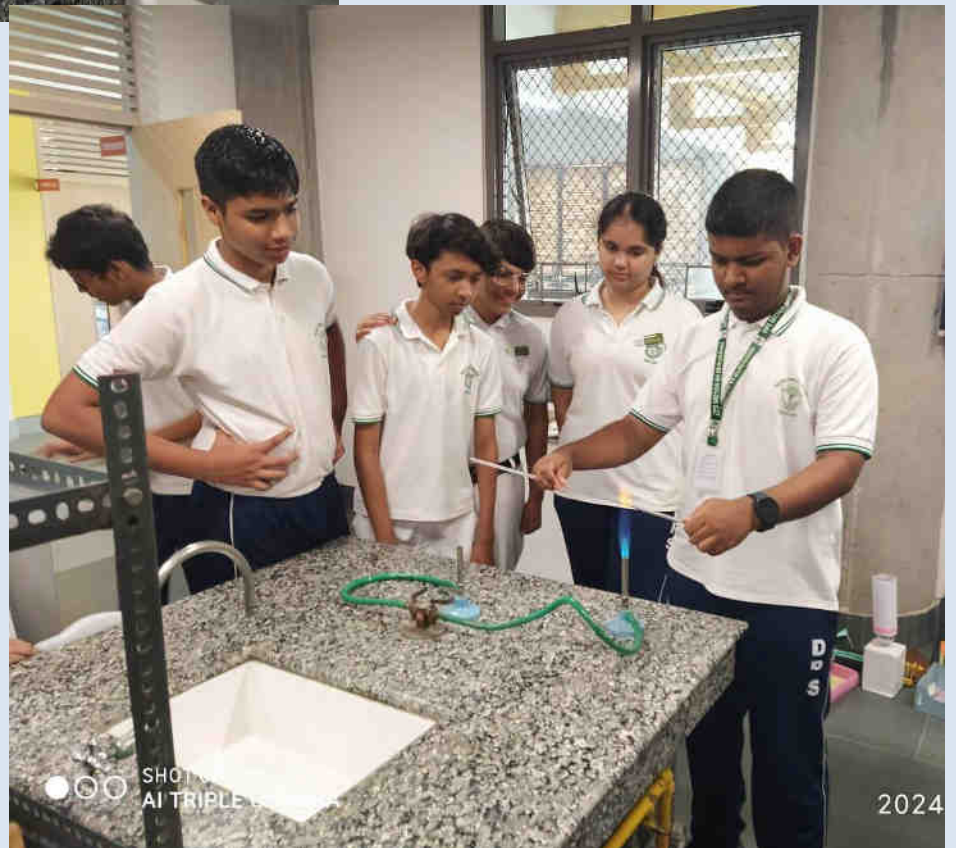
## LEARNING BY DOING

## EXPLORING NUMBERS THROUGH PLAY

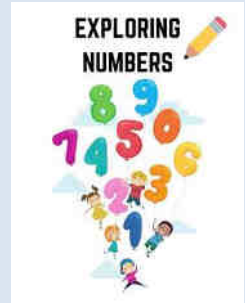
