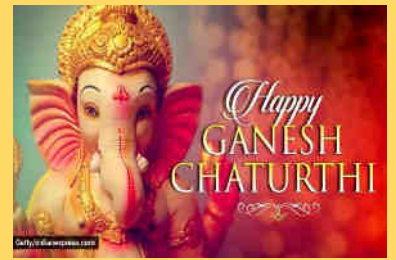
May Lord Ganesha give you- A rainbow for every storm, A smile for every tear, A promise for every care and an answer to every prayer.
