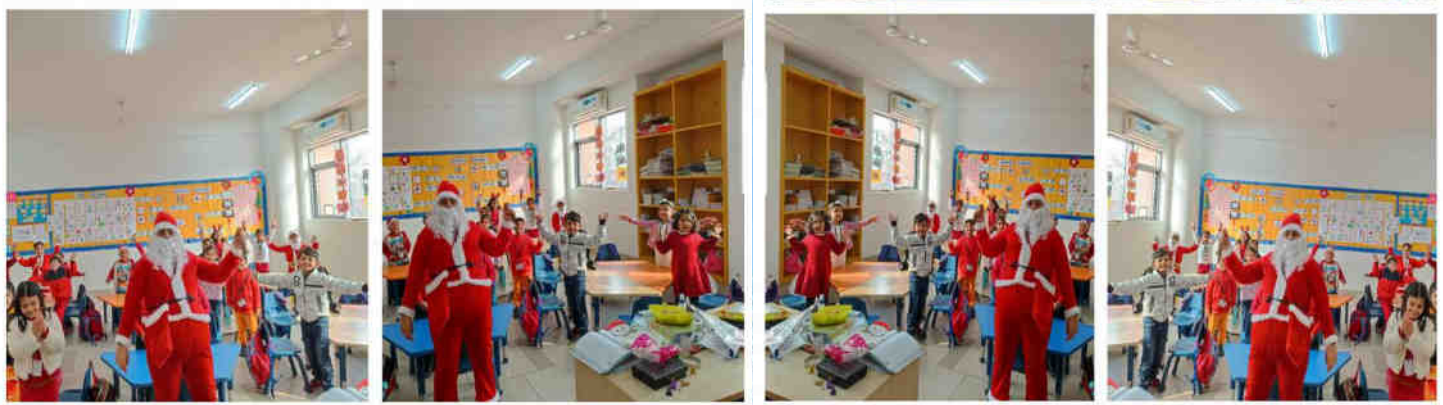

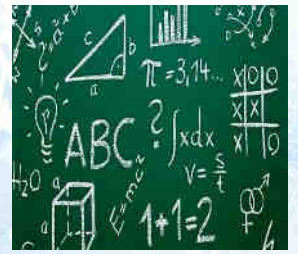

The event gave good exposure and confidence to the young minds.

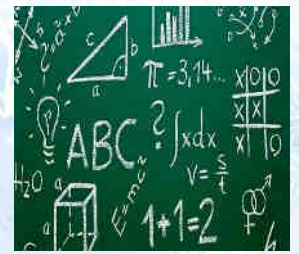

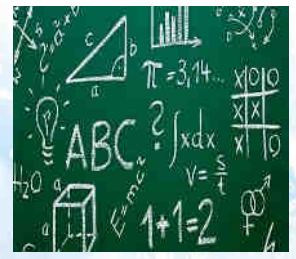

# NATIONAL MATHEMATICS WEEK



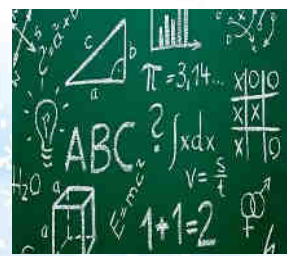
We at DPS 84, were excited to take up maths activities during the Maths week held in school from 19th to 22nd December.

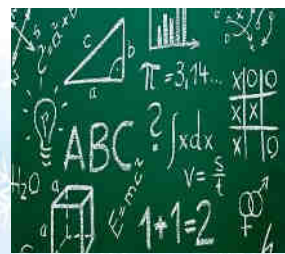

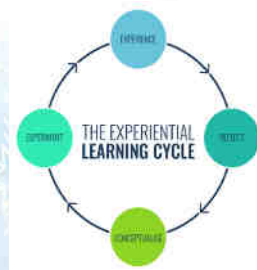
**“My Favourite Community Helper”**

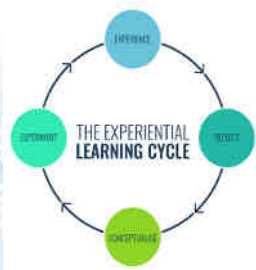

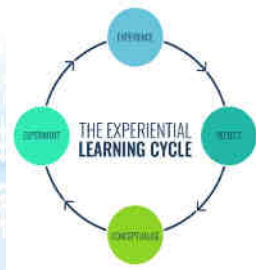
**Dress & Tell Activity: My Favourite Festival**

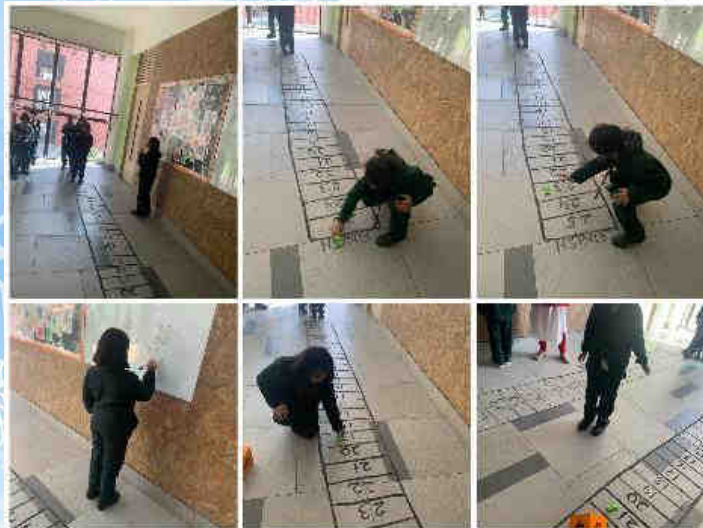
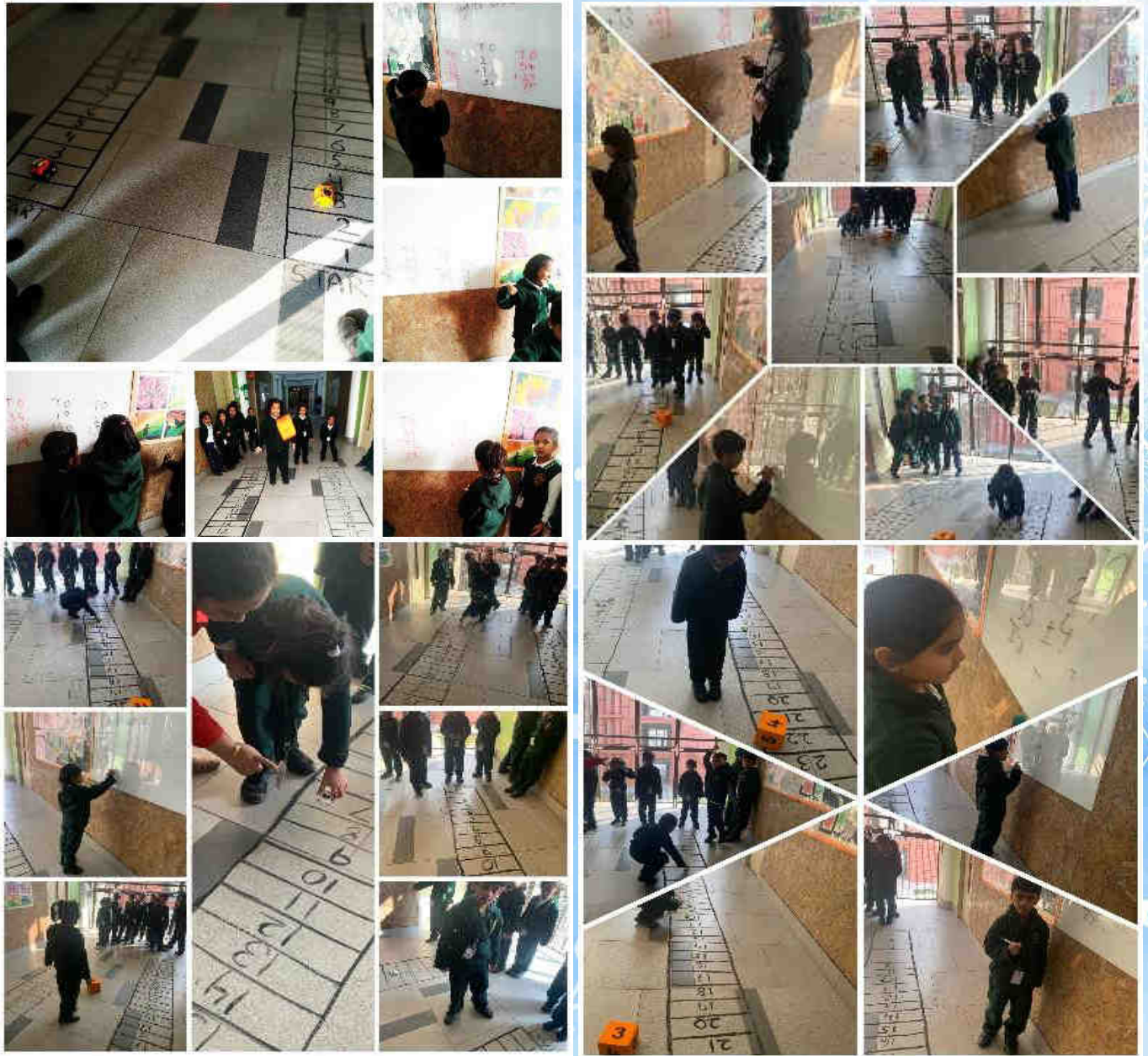
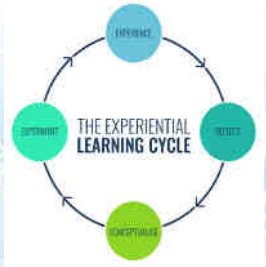
## Mathematics-CAR RACE ACTIVITY

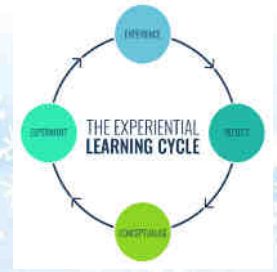

**Learning with robots also develops a range of other skills such as problem-solving, analytical reasoning and computational thinking.**

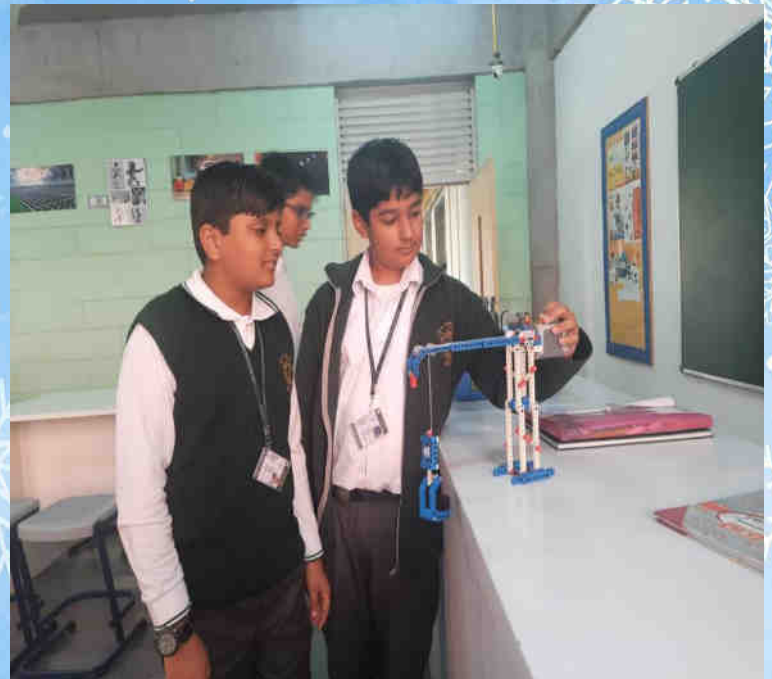
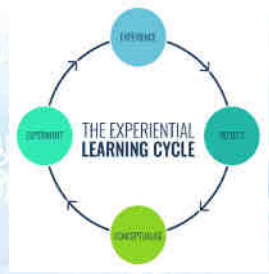

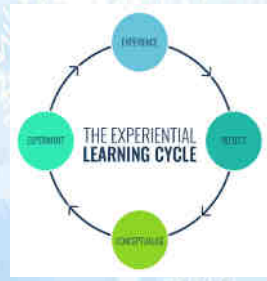
## Class- IV SST

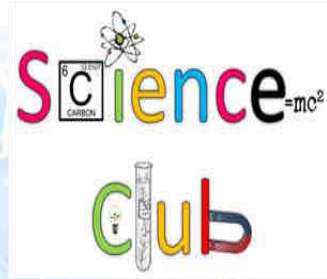
The activity brought out the creativity of the enthusiastic explorers apart from helping them understand the various formations using 3D shapes.

Eco Club

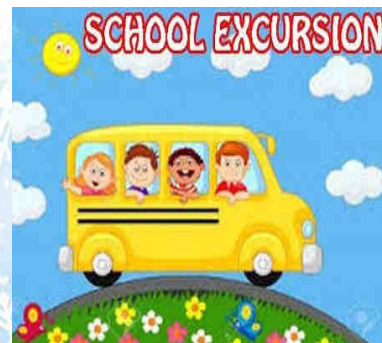

All the organic waste was mixed in the compost pile. This hands-on experience helped them to connect with the nature and make real contribution to the community.
