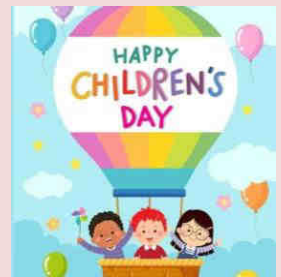

## 3D GEOMETRIC SHAPES

Shapes are an early introduction to geometry, laying the groundwork for future math learning. Understanding shapes helps children with concepts such as symmetry, counting, and spatial awareness. Learning about names and properties of shapes enhances vocabulary development. Students learn using descriptive words like 'round, square, straight and curved'. Today, the students of Class Prep learned about the 'cone' shape. As part of the lesson, they made a cone-shaped carrot. This hands-on activity helped them understand the 3D shape of a cone and made learning fun for them.

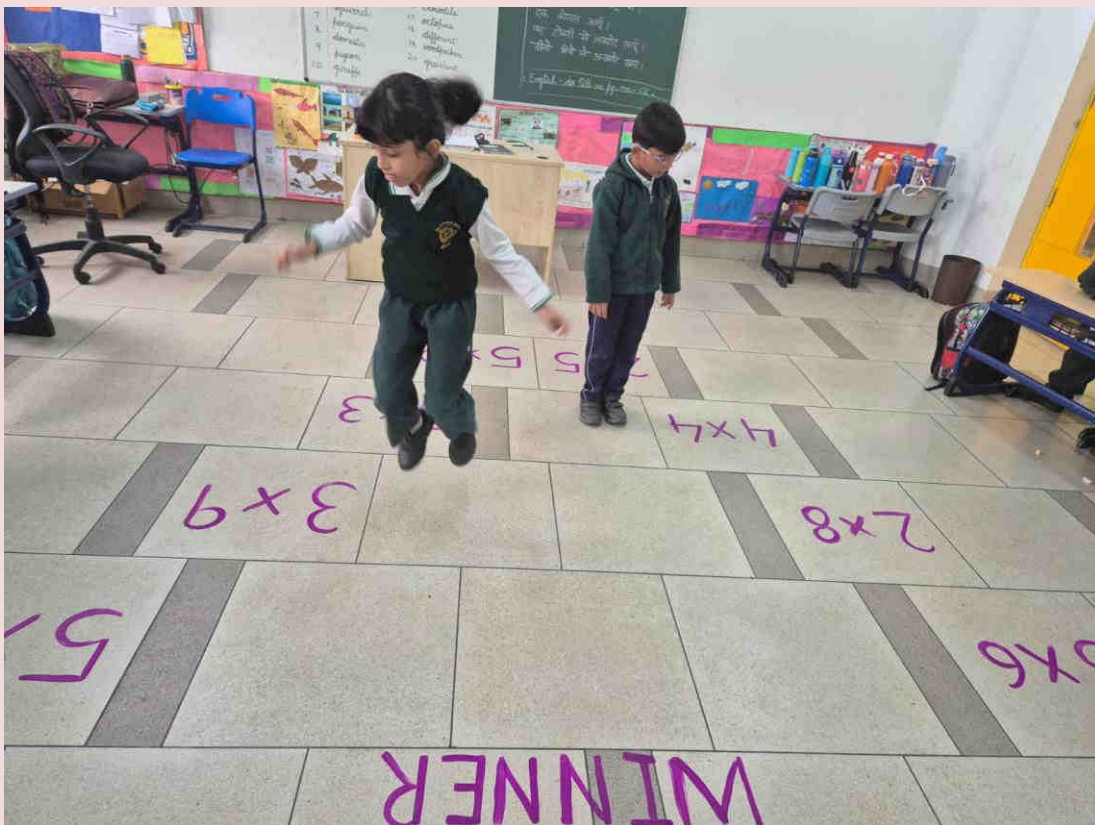




# HOPSCOTCH



Hopscotch is a classic playground game that can be transformed into an engaging way to practice multiplication. By combining physical activity with math, this version of hopscotch helps students reinforce their times tables while having fun. To set up, a traditional hopscotch grid is drawn with chalk, the squares are then numbered from 1 to 10. However, instead of simply jumping, students must solve multiplication problems as they play. For example: each square can represent a multiple of a chosen number, like the 2s, 3s, 4s or 5s, and the child hops to the square and tells the product. This approach to learning multiplication is not only interesting but also interactive as it promotes physical coordination and memory retention. It encourages a multi-sensory learning experience where students are engaged mentally and physically, making math practice more enjoyable. Hopscotch for multiplication can be played individually or in groups, fostering teamwork, healthy competition, and active learning. This playful activity enabled students to build confidence in their multiplication skills and develop a more positive attitude toward math.



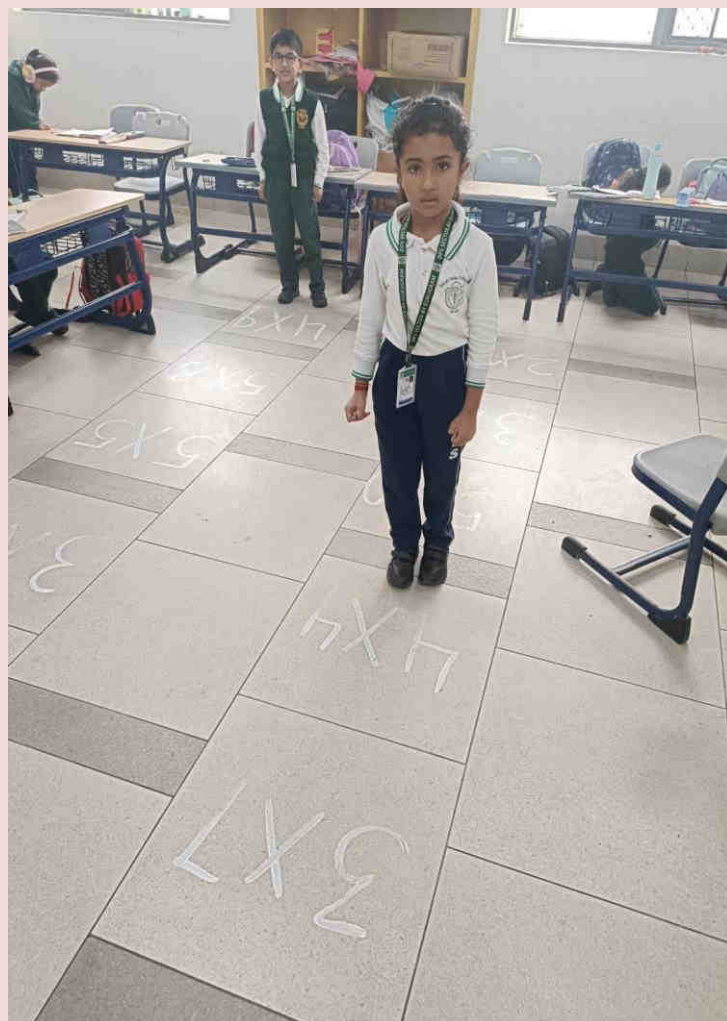
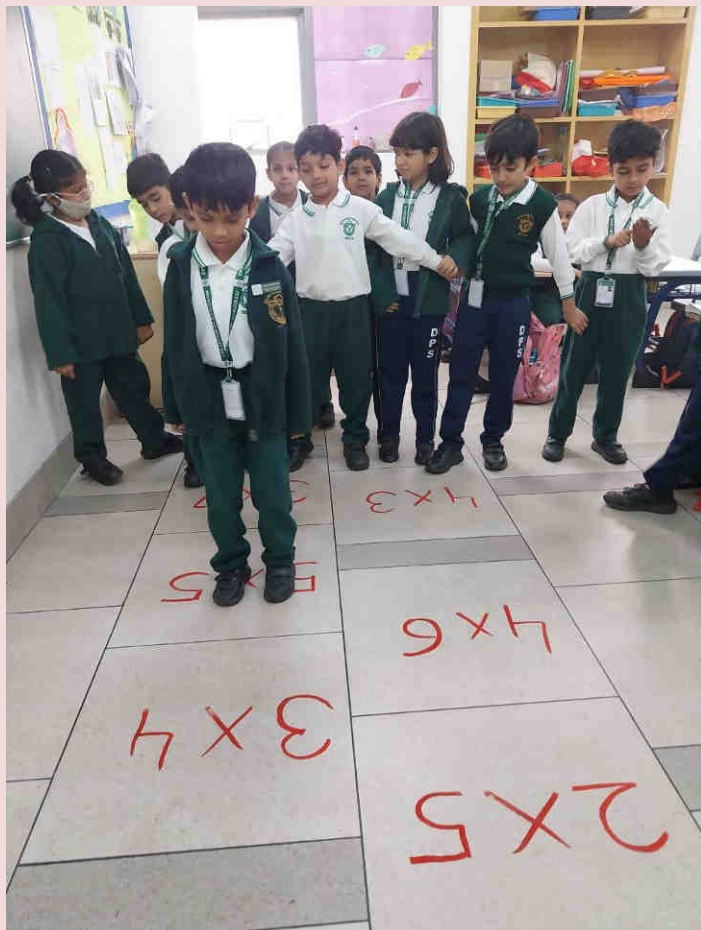

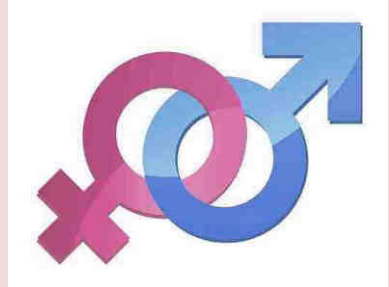

At DPS 84, we are committed to organizing workshops like these to help our students develop a strong foundation for healthy living. Here's to nurturing healthier futures!





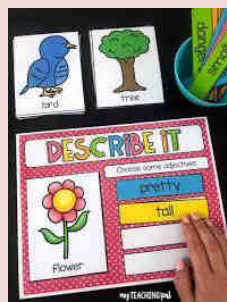

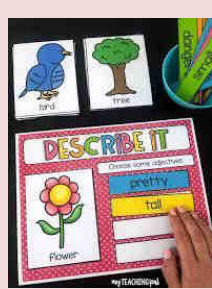

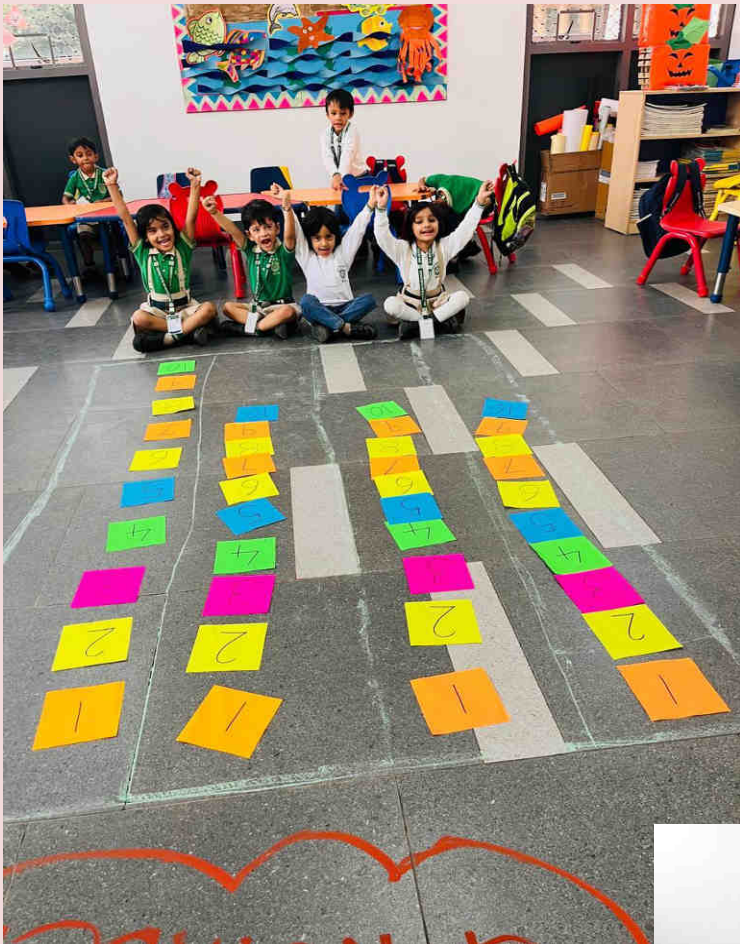
## ACTIVITY-NUMBER TRAIN

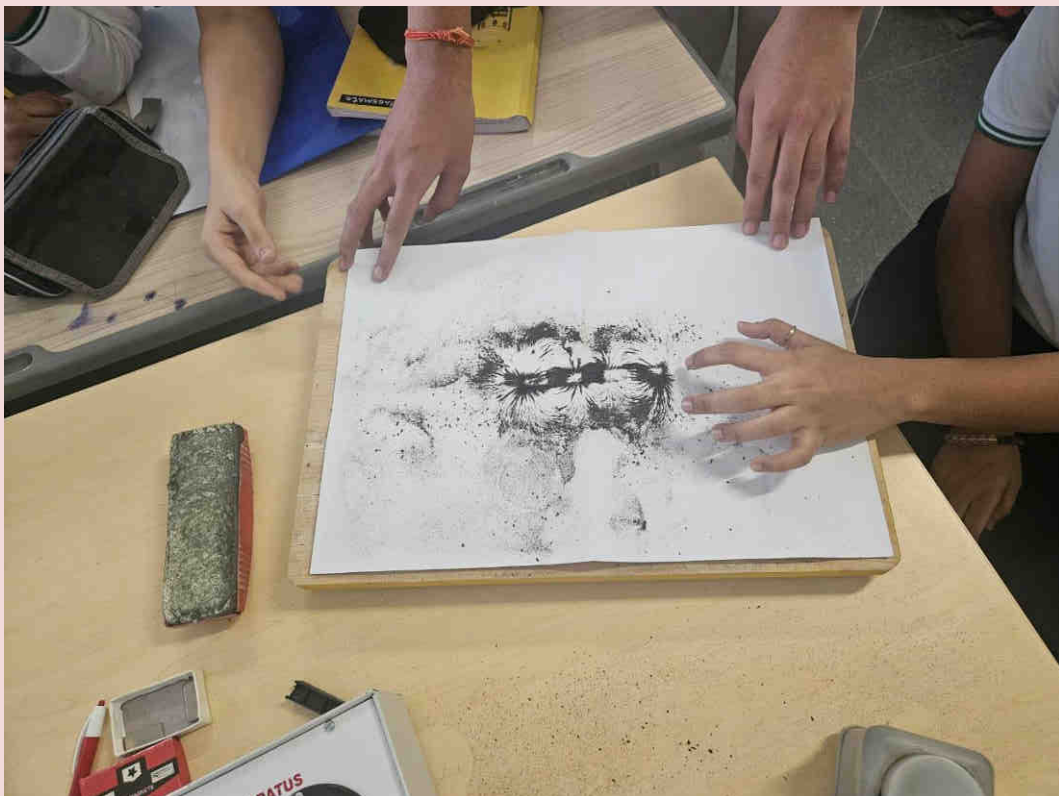


## EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING



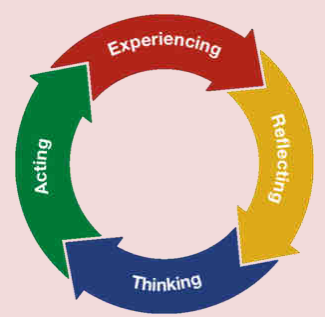
At DPS84, experiential learning is an integral component of our curriculum, allowing students to engage with concepts actively and practically. Recently, our Grade X physics students took part in a hands-on activity focusing on magnets, magnetic fields, and magnetic field lines. This approach not only helped students understand theoretical concepts but also deepened their comprehension through direct experience.

In the activity, students were provided with bar magnets, iron filings, and compasses to visualize the invisible forces of magnetic fields. By sprinkling iron filings around the magnet, they could observe how these filings aligned along invisible lines, forming a clear pattern of magnetic field lines. This visual experience brought the concept of magnetic fields to life, enabling students to see the effects of magnetic forces firsthand. With the help of compasses, students also investigated how magnetic field lines originate from the magnet's north pole and curve around to the south pole, helping them understand the directional nature of magnetic fields. They experimented with placing multiple magnets in various configurations to observe how the field lines interacted—sometimes attracting, sometimes repelling—which illustrated the behaviour of magnetic fields in different contexts. Experiential learning sessions like these not only solidify conceptual understanding but also foster curiosity and analytical skills as students pose questions and find answers through direct interaction with the materials. By engaging in practical, sensory experiences, students develop a more profound and lasting comprehension of physics, that prepare them for future learning challenges with a solid foundation in scientific inquiry.

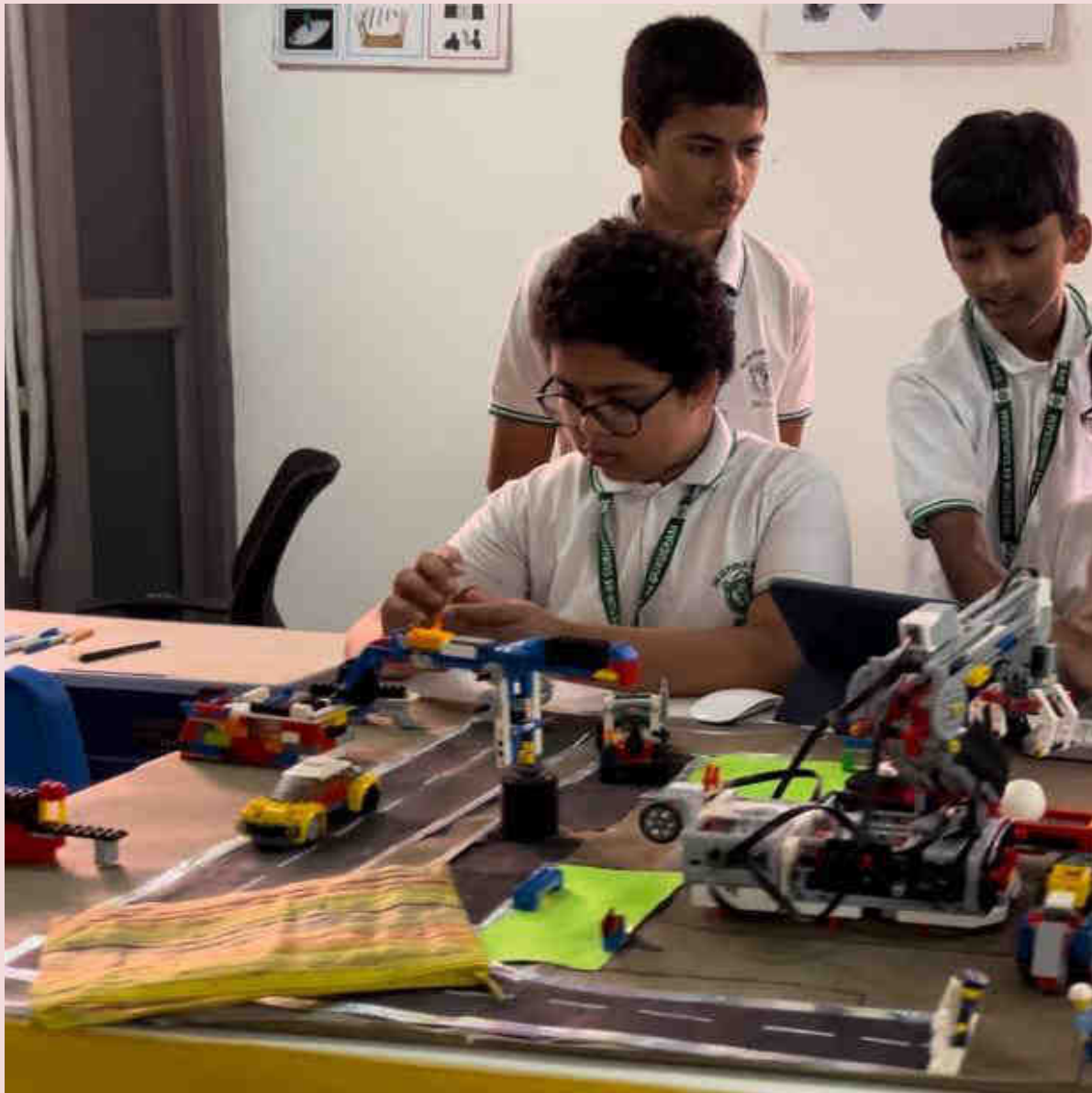

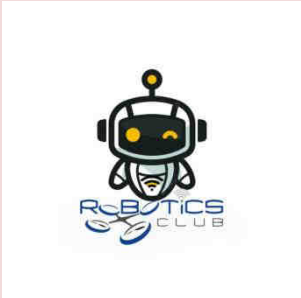

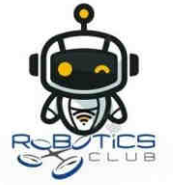
