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HINDI DIWAS



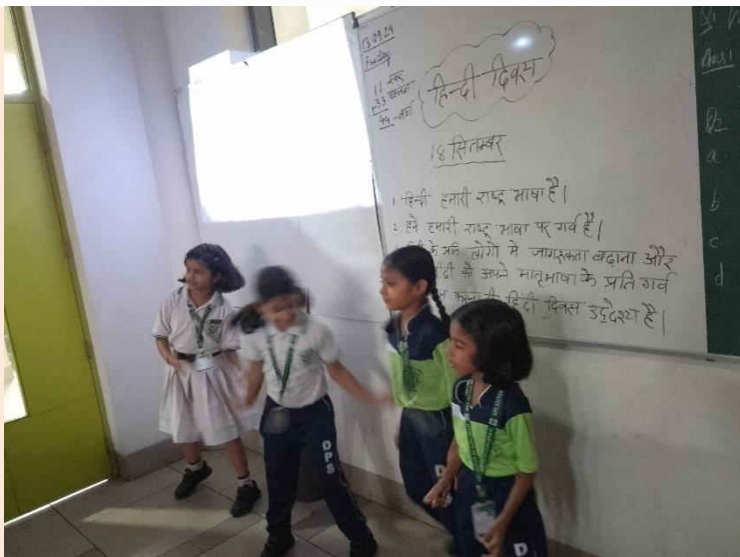

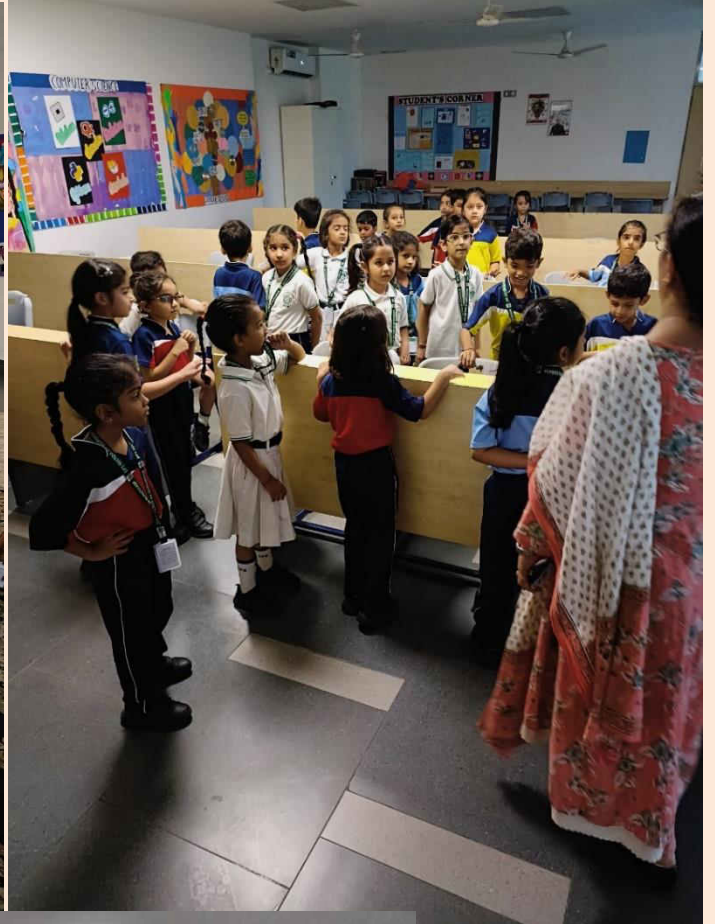

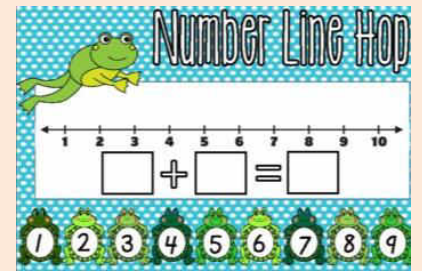

ACTIVITY-NUMBER LINE HOPPING



Children had fun participating in the 'Number line' activity where they had to stand on a number on the number line (made on the floor) and then based on the number on the dice rolled by the child the child will either move forward or backward on the number line.

Why a number line? It is a great way to help children visualize the relationships between numbers... As they enjoy hopping around, seeing numbers laid out in a linear format, (like a number line) all kinds of number relationships seeds get planted up and down on the number line.

For example, if a child is standing on 4 and is said to jump forward 2 more, the child makes the connection that 2 more than 4 is 6. In time, children begin to visualize the order of numbers which supports mental math strategies down the road.

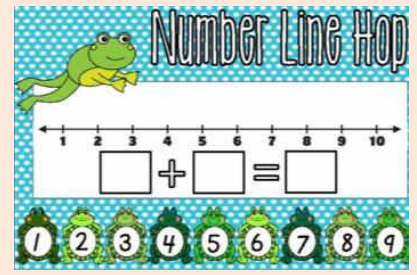
The activity of number line hopping helped them understand clearly the concept of addition and subtraction on number line.

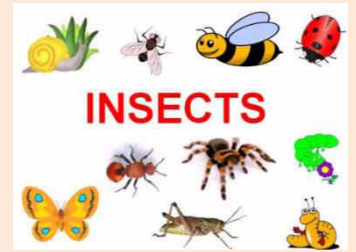

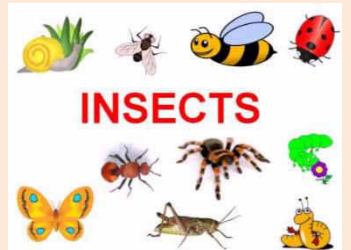
