
















Raksha Bandhan

The students of Grade II expressed their love through their handmade rakhi, rakhi ki thali and wrapping gifts along with some heart-touching messages to express their love and affection.














dressing up in accordance to that and also presenting models based on it.














Grade-II MATH




KIENSTHETIC
