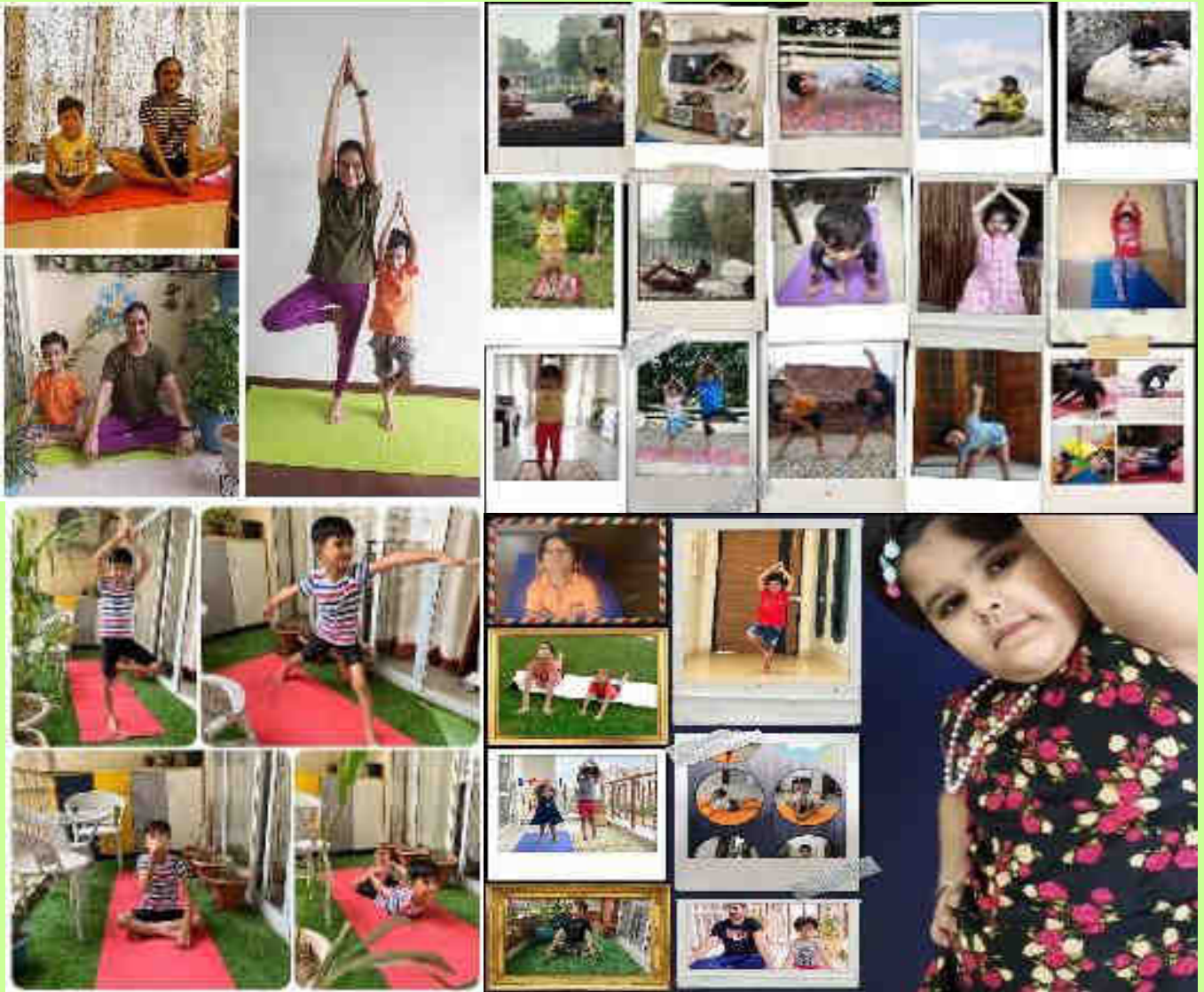

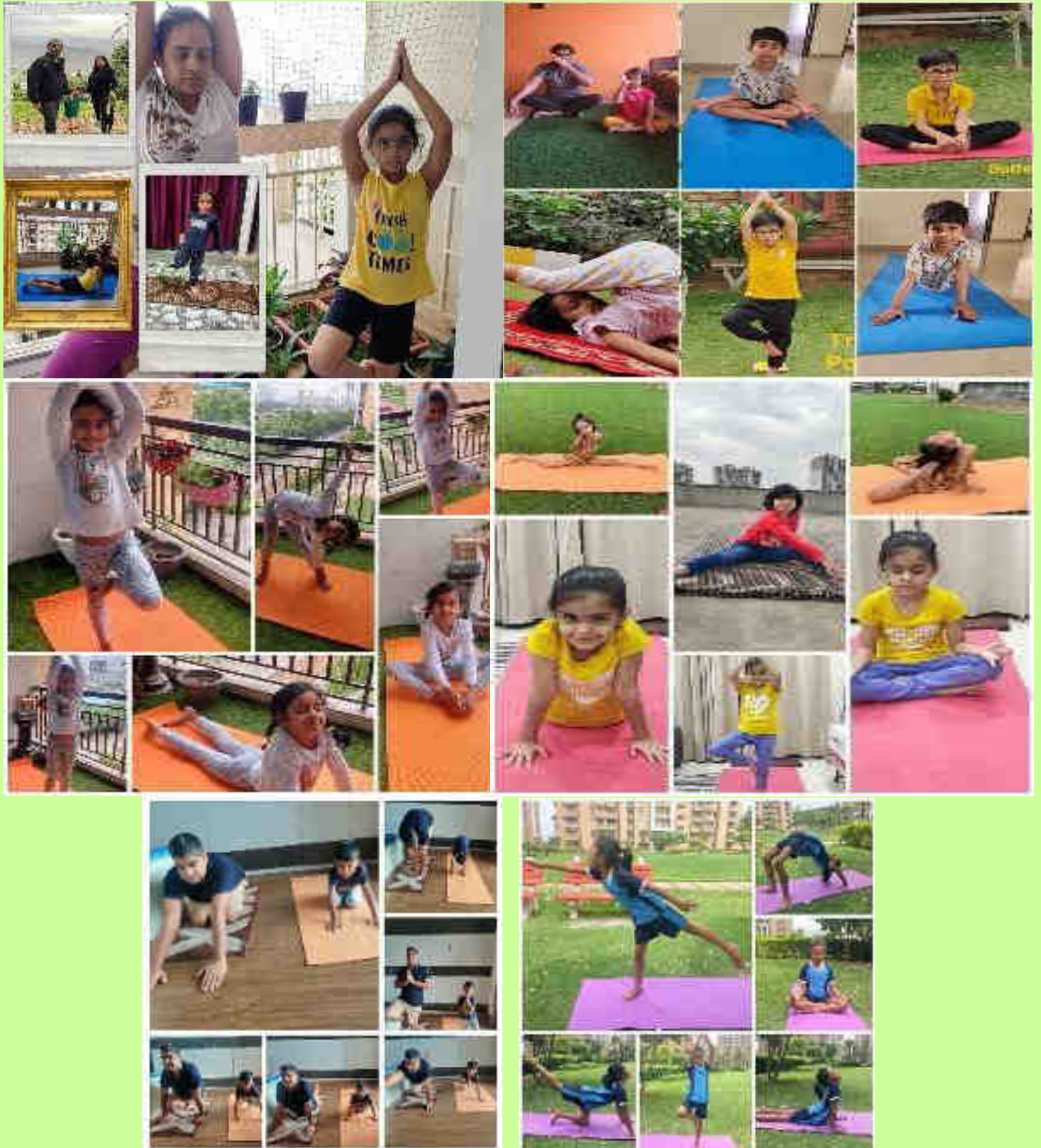
“Yoga is the journey of the self, to the self, through the self.” - The Bhagvad Gita

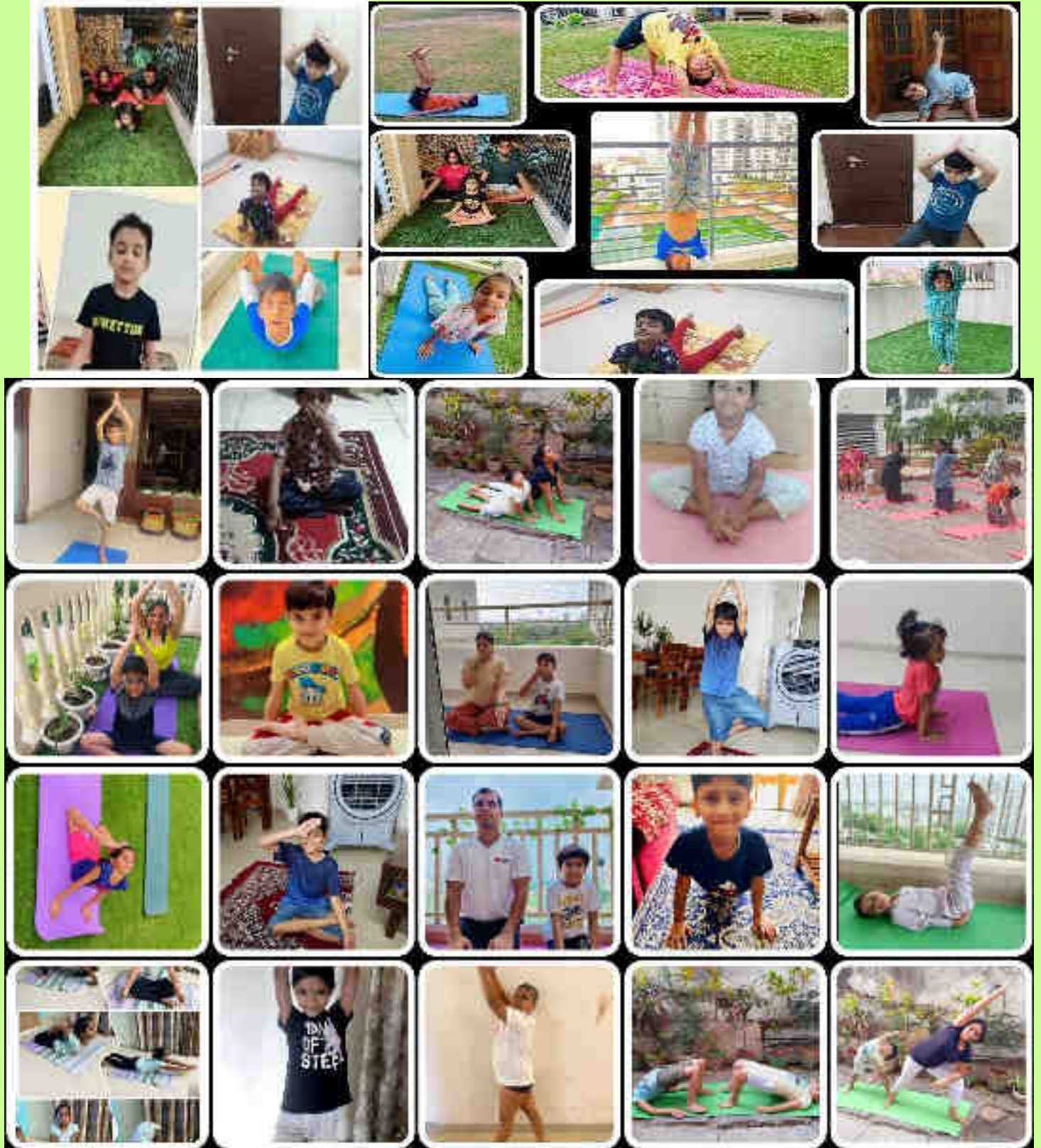

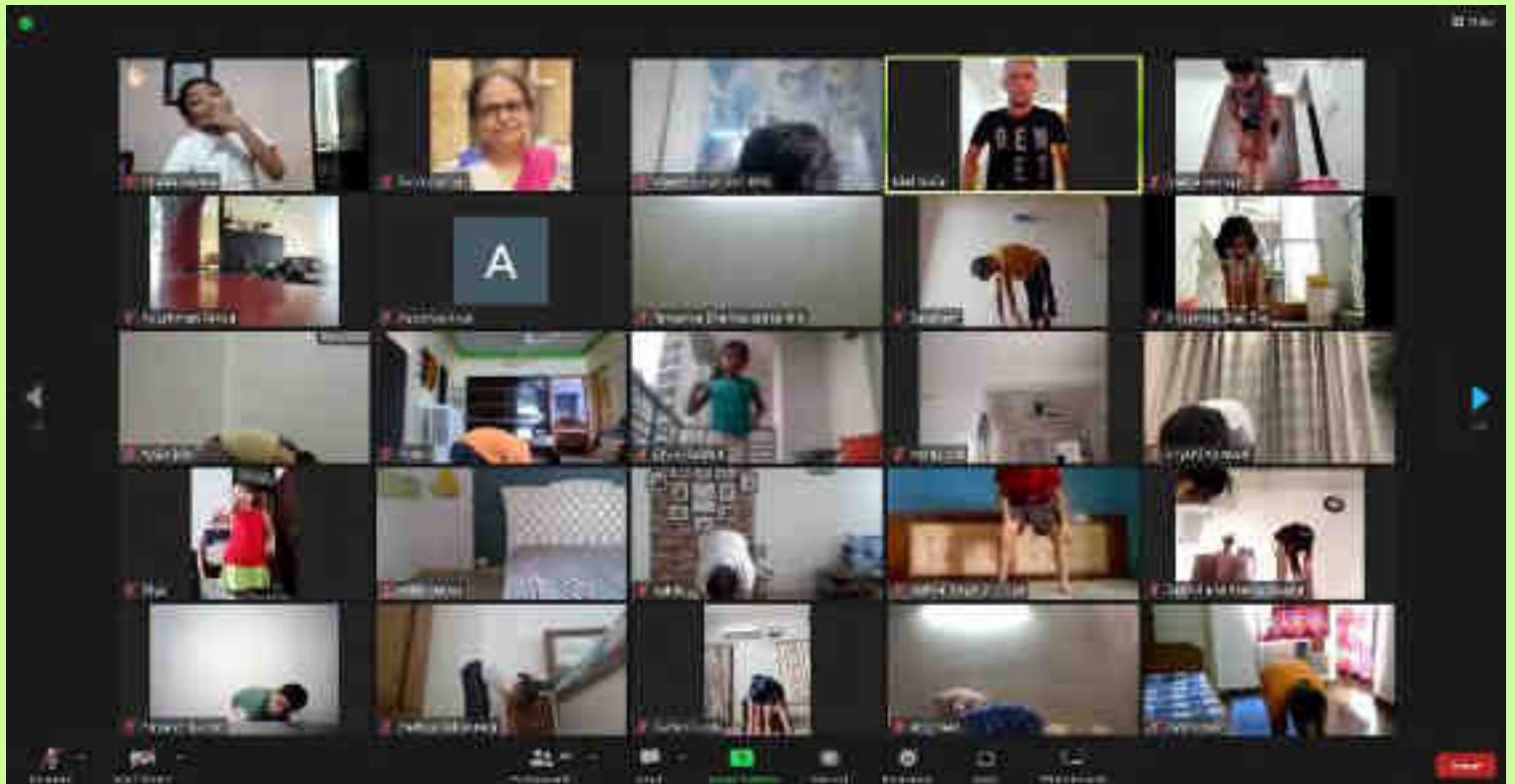


INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY



Grade - 3, 4 and 5

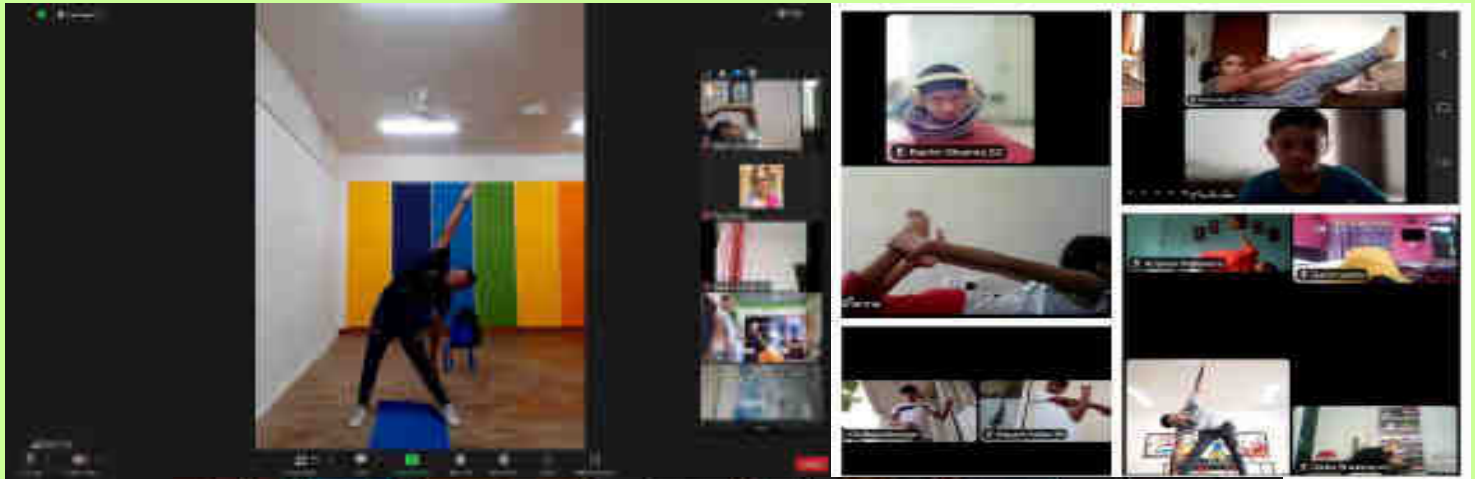

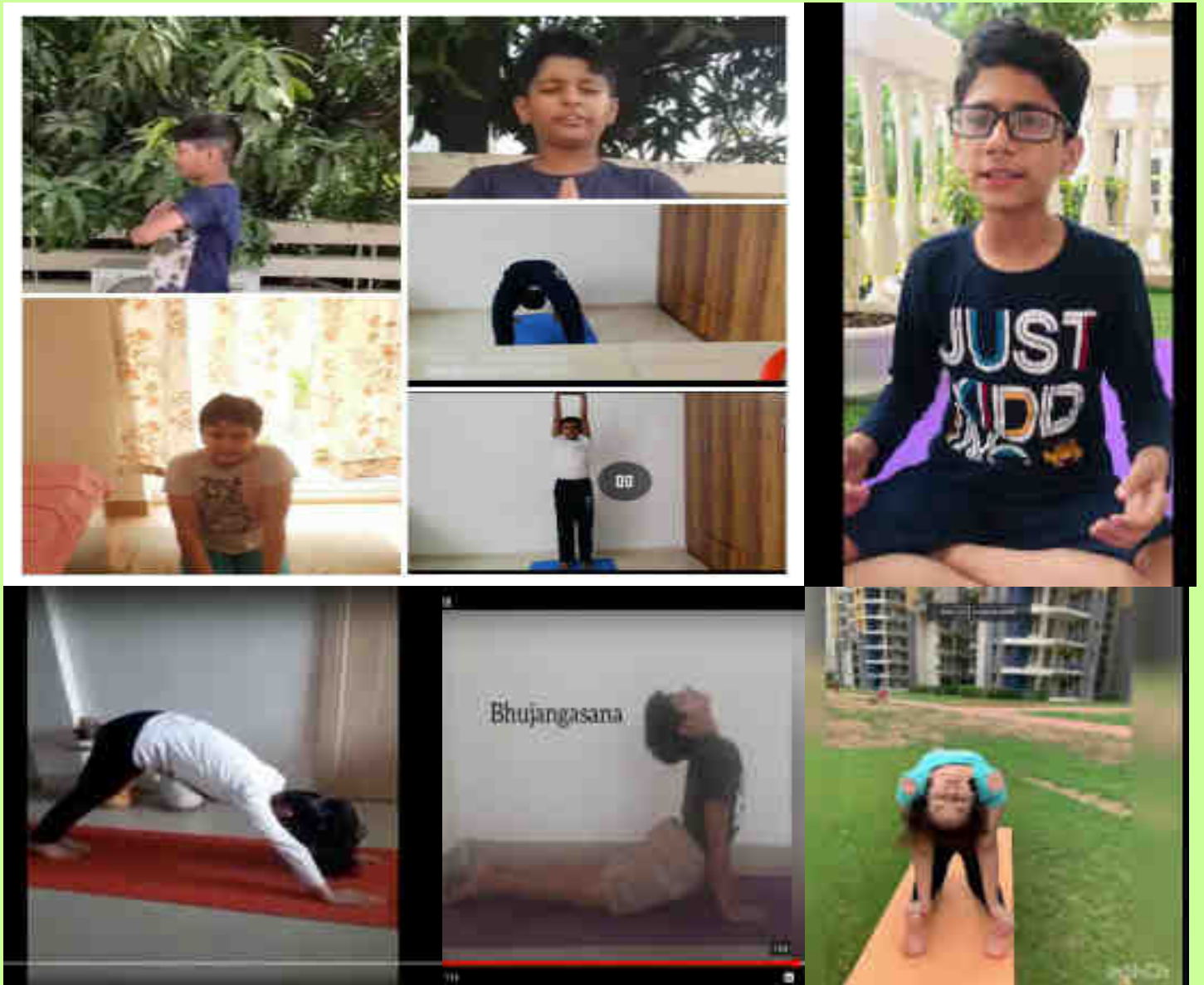
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INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

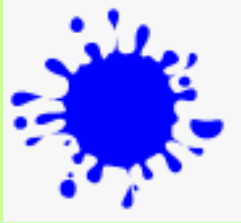

Class: Pre-Nursery

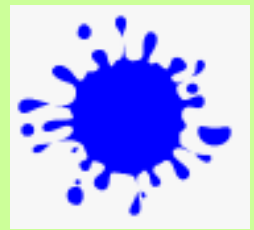
“Kiddies paint their moods in shades of blue”
