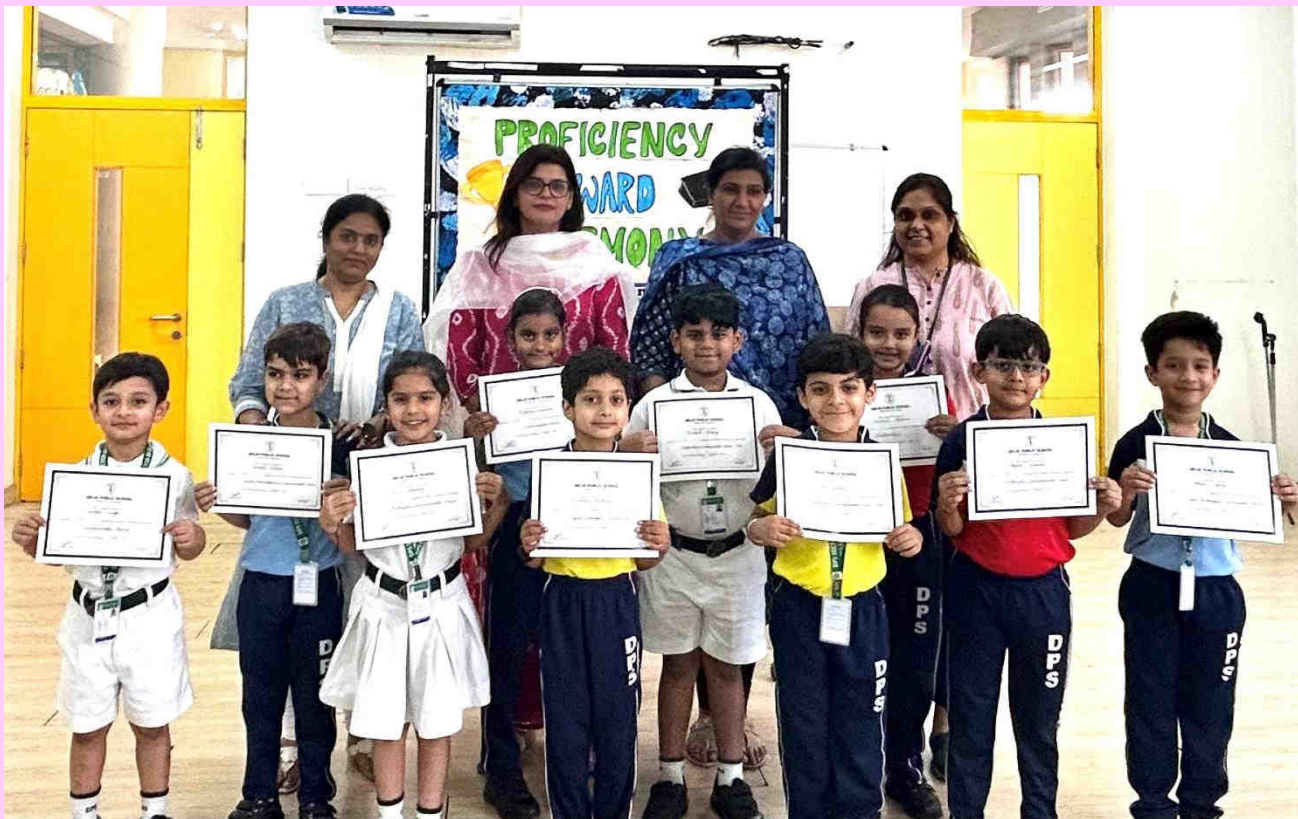

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EVS- Grade I

At DPS, Sec84 students conducted an experiment to grasp the importance of using soap while washing their hands. The objective was to visually demonstrate how soap effectively reduces the spread of germs, using ground black pepper to represent germs. The experiment clearly illustrated the importance of using soap when washing hands. While water alone may not effectively remove germs, the addition of soap significantly enhances cleanliness and reduces the risk of spreading infections. The visual demonstration helped students understand that soap is crucial in maintaining hygiene and preventing illness.
