SUBTRACTION TRAIN ACTIVITY





The activity not only helped strengthen students' understanding of subtraction but also promoted skills such as:


- Problem-solving and logical thinking

The Subtraction Train Activity proved to be a delightful blend of learning and fun, encouraging students to explore math in a meaningful and enjoyable way.




